Behind this basic thesis, the book defends the idea of a global ethic. Global ethic means an ethic which acknowledges respect for human life and

These questions have been salient in the context of the Balkan and African wars and U.S.

policy in the Middle East. This volume undertakes a serious, systematic, and broadly international review of the issues.
